Proposing a New Member:

Candidates for membership must love the theatre and be willing to read various roles over the seasons when asked by a producer to join a particular cast. Candidates must also be able to either host 40+ members for play-reading and dinner or – if their living space does not permit – co-host at another member's home, thereby picking up 50% of the expenses. This obligation is due every other season.

A candidate for membership in QP must have attended two previous play-readings as a guest of one or more of the members.

A candidate is proposed by a QP member and seconded by a another. The proposal takes the form of a letter to the current president, introducing the proposed candidate with a little history, background, etc. A third member is asked to also write a brief note about the candidate. E-mails are fine.

This material is shared by the president with the current advisory committee (two immediate past presidents and one lay member). If all is well, the president announces in a memo to the membership that such and such a candidate has been proposed for membership and will be accepted within 30 days unless someone strenuously objects.

An acceptance letter and other QP materials are then sent to the new member.
